In SIX Swiss Exchange message no. 26/2021, the Swiss Stock Exchange has announced the extension of the launch promotion for Liquidity Providers in the trading service "Quote on Demand".

SIX Swiss Exchange is pleased to extend the duration of the launch promotion for the Liquidity Providers of the Quote on Demand trading service one last time beyond 31 December 2021. SIX Swiss Exchange will not charge any trading and capacity fees for Liquidity Providers in Quote on Demand for the period from 1 January 2022 until 31 March 2022.

The terms and conditions for the extended trading and capacity launch promotion for Quote on Demand Liquidity Providers take effect on 1 January 2022 and can be downloaded from the website of SIX Swiss Exchange: https://www.six-group.com/en/products-services/the-swiss-stock-exchange/trading/tradingprovisions/regulation.html#scrollTo=feepromotion

Please note that the standard value for the minimum number of responding liquidity providers for automatic execution ("Auto-Execute") for the trading service "Quote on Demand" is set to 1 instead of 3 in accordance with Guideline Trading Parameters Annex I and Q - Clause 2 para. 5 until 31 March 2022.
