### Content of this message:

- SMR11 is a **mandatory** Maintenance Release of the SWXess trading platform
  - Enhancements and additional optimizations for trading on the exchange and trade reporting
  - Introduction of SMR11 in the Membertest environment planned on 31 October 2022 and 23 January 2023 as well as in the Production environment planned on 3 April 2023

The Swiss Stock Exchange is introducing a further upgrade of its SWXess trading platform as part of its ongoing optimization efforts. The SWXess Maintenance Release 11 (SMR11) contains **mandatory** adjustments to the SWXess interfaces and primarily serves to introduce enhancements and optimizations to on exchange trading. Furthermore, it will introduce adjustments to trade reporting.

### Rollout

The rollout of SMR11 to the Membertest and Production environment has been scheduled for the following dates:

Date	Activity
31 October 2022	Introduction of <b>SMR11</b> (Phase 1) <b>in the Membertest</b> environment*
23 January 2023	Introduction of <b>SMR11</b> (Phase 2) <b>in the Membertest</b> environment
3 April 2023	Introduction of <b>SMR11 in the Production</b> environment
15 May 2023	<b>Contingency date</b> for the introduction of SMR11 in the Production environment

\* The start of the Membertest Phase 1 does not involve any mandatory adjustments to the SWXess interfaces, and the software compatibility between the Membertest and Production environment remains unchanged.

### Release Guide and Specifications of SWXess interfaces

SIX Swiss Exchange AG will publish the “[SMR11 Release Guide](#)” in September 2022 for the first time, providing the information on functional and technical changes for the Membertest Phases 1 and 2 and will announce it by means of a SIX Swiss Exchange message.
